Suburban Soul is a half term of youth activities seeks to bless our community as well as raise the profile of the church in the area. Through encouraging and using the passion of young people positively in mission and evangelism we want to be an inspiration to the wider church.

This year (2007) Suburban Soul runs from Wednesday the 24th to Sunday 28th October and all young people year 9 and above are invited to join in. Wednesday – Friday of Suburban Soul starts with mornings of teaching and fellowship followed by lunch before we head off to our various projects. Projects are centred around Kingston and New Malden and range from Kids work, a senior citizens project to street evangelism (including thought provoking displays, vox pops and good old fashioned having a bit of a chat to kids hanging around the town). There is a special family celebration on the Saturday afternoon in which delegates are invited to come and join in the fun with its inflatable games, Wii tournaments and kids activities. At the end of the week, on the Sunday evening we will then gather together at the Christchurch New Malden evening service where together we will celebrate God and the life he has called us to.

Our vision is that Suburban Soul is something that will affect people's views of God and his people, for them to see that he is loving and exciting God, and to serve him is a celebration of who he is and what he's given us. We want to impact the young people who get involved and grow in their faith by putting it into action.

The cost to take part in Suburban Soul is just £10 and covers lunch each day and a fabulous Suburban Soul t shirt. You don't have to come for the whole week, those who can just come for a day will be just as welcome.
